TROFEE MEET – TROPHY MEASURE

Agtergrond:

Ons jag eties.

Wat om te weet vir jou trofee wat gemeet moet word:

Slegs trofee wat gejag is vanaf 1 September 2017 tot 31 Augustus 2018 kom in aan merking vir erkening by hoof kantoor (Rowland Ward).

Ou trofee word net vir tak doeleindes gemeet.

Rowland Ward word nie erken deur hoof kantoor nie.

Trofee wat gemonteer is kan gemeet word, op jou risiko. Dit kan dan ook volgende jaar ingeskryf word vir meeting.

Junior jagters moet 10 jaar oud wees wanneer die jag plaas gevind het, vir sy/ haar trofee om gemeet kan word.

Kleur variasies van spesies word nie erken nie. Sal dit in die data basis insluit op tak vlak.

Background:

We hunt ethically

What you need to know for your trophy to be measured:

Only trophies that is hunted from 1 September 2017 tot 31 Augustus 2018, will be considered for recognition by head office (Rowland Ward).

Old trophies will only be measured for branch purposes. Rowland Ward will not be recognised by head office.

Trophies that are with the taxidermist can be submitted the following year. Mounted trophies will be measured on your risk.

Junior hunters must have been 10 years old when the hunt took place. His / her trophy will then be measured.

Colour variances of species will not be recognised at all. The data will be taken and kept at branch level.

Inskrywings:

Slegs op betaalde lede kan deelneem.

Junior lid moet op betaald wees met n lid nommer.

Moet persoonlik gejag wees deur die junior lid.

Dokumentasie:

Die volgende moet aangebied word:

- Waar is trofee gejag
- Wanneer is trofee gejag, datum om te bewys dat jag wettig was
- Jaglisensie van die provinsie waar gejag is

Waar vrystelling is moet n brief van die eienaar of verteenwoordiger waarop vrystellingsnommer van jagplaas wees. Onderteken deur eienaar en of verteenwoordiger. Die jagter moet dit ook onder teken.

'n CITES permit en of TOPS permit in die geval van CITES en of NEMBA se skedule vir skaars, bedreigde of beskermde wild moet aansoek vergesel

'n Fotostaat van bogenoemde dokumentasie moet aan die inskrywingvorm geheg word. Sal vir 5 jaar bewaar word.

Entries:

Only paid up members will qualify.

Junior members must be paid up with a number.

The trophy must be hunted by the junior self.

Documentation:

The following must be available:

- Where the trophy was hunted
- When did the hunt take place, date to proof that the hunt was legal
- Hunters license from the province where the hunt took place and

In case of an exempted farm, a letter from the owner or representative with the exemption number of the hunting farm. It must be signed by both parties involved.

Where a CITES permit and or TOPS permit is relevant it must accompany the documentation for scarce or threatened or protected species as required by national nature conversation legislation.

Photocopy of all documentation must accompany the entry form. The documentation will be kept for 5 years.

Buiteland:

Trofee wat in buite land gejag is moet die volgende vergesel:

- Jaglisensie van die land waar gejag is
- Die jagter se naam moet op die lisensie voorkom
- Dokumentasie om te bewys dat die trofee ingevoer is

- n CITES permit in die geval van n CITES skedule vir skaars of bedreigde spesie word vereis
- Fotos van die jag van die trofee

Indien dokumentasie nie die inskrywingsvorm as bewys mee maak nie sal die trofee nie aanvaar word nie.

Other Countries:

When hunting outside RSA the following documentation must accompany the entry:

- Hunting license from the country where the trophy was hunted
- The hunter's name must be on the license from that country
- Documentation as proof that the trophy was imported legally
- CITES permit must accompany the CITES schedule where rare or endangered specie was hunted
- Photos of the trophy hunted

Trophies entered without the required documentation as proof of a legal hunt, will not be allowed at all.
