

SPRINGBOK BRANCH "SUPER SKINS" COMPETITION RULES 2 March 2019



The shoot will be shot with rifles, ammunition and equipment as stated below.

Participants should please keep in mind that our "Super Skins" is a Fun Shoot and that we have tried to hold to the spirit of a "Skins Competition."

We also are interested in data pertaining to Rifle Names, telescope names and calibers.
Please ensure that your enrollment forms are **completed in full**.

This is not a group shoot, however shots closest to the six "bulls" will carry the highest scores.

The shoot will take place from a sitting position over a supplied shooting table over a distance between 100 and 180 meters. Targets as supplied by the Springbok Branch will be used. The distance to target will be announced that day and will be determined by "lucky draw" on the day of the shoot.

Shottists will be allowed to fire six (6) shots at one target, consisting out of six target areas (being grouped in a single group, thus making it 1 group of six targets. Any ammunition deemed by the shooter to be of safe design for the rifle in question will be allowed.(bought, borrowed or self-loaded).

Own rifle or borrowed rifle is good. However in the case of not owning the rifle, the legal owner of such rifle must be present and be in possession of a license for the rifle in question.

All participants that own a rifle have to be in possession of a valid license for that rifle.

Silencers, flash breakers or any other attachment, that is safe to use will be allowed. There is no restriction to barrel length or girth. Telescopes however will be locked at 10 magnification. **Computerized or self adjusting scopes will not be allowed.**

EAR AND EYE PROTECTION TO BE WORN AT ALL TIMES DURING SHOOT. Can be bought at container if forgotten or left at home.

The use of alcohol before and or during the shoot will not be allowed or tolerated. Zero tolerance.

RIFLES:

Any center fire rifle may be used. There are no limits on barrel length, girth or attachments.

TELESCOPES:

Any standard sight or telescope will be allowed. Magnification will be set and locked at 10 times max. Locking stickers will be supplied at rifle check-in.

No ELECTRONIC telescopes will be allowed.

RIFLE BARRELS.

Any length, girth, width, caliber as long as it is center-fire is welcome.

Any attachment to barrel will be allowed. Silencers, compensators, flash breakers etc. are all welcome.

Harris bipods, tri pods etc. may be attached to rifle or barrel **but may not be used to shoot from.**

Equipment:

No other rests, posts, bi and tri pods, etc. may be used. Only shooting tables, sandbags and equipment as provided by the organizers on that day may be made use of.

Ammunition.

Any type of ammunition that may safely be fired from the rifle, any grain and bullet may be used.

It however, at all times, remains the responsibility of the shooter, to ensure that the correct ammunition for the rifle is used. Enrolling in this competition will indicate that the sole responsibility of the aforementioned will be that of the participant. The Springbok Branch will NOT at any stage accept or be held responsible should incorrect ammunition be used and such action results in damage, injury or death.

Range Committee:

A Range committee will be appointed before the commencement of the "Super Skins".

Decisions pertaining matters in connection with the said shoot shall be made by this committee and will be final. This committee shall decide upon matters pertaining the shoot, the sealing of telescopes and any other matter that might arise before and during the shoot.



SPRINGBOK branch "SUPER SKINS" 2019 summarized.

1. Relays will be limited to a maximum time frame of fifteen (15) minutes. Each relay will consist of a maximum of (30) participating shooters.
2. Participants will each have a single target that he may shoot at. Every and each target will have a total of six (6) bulls to be hit. Thus a total of 6 bulls per relay.

A participating shooter will need six (6) rounds of ammunition to complete his or her exercise.
Only correct and suitable ammunition for the rifle being utilized, may be used. The onus rests with the shooter.
Each "BULL" has a maximum count of ten (10) Even missing the bull but hitting the target area might result in a score.
Each target area with six (6) bulls will be eligible for a prize. That means that for every six (6) rounds a participant will have a chance to win a prize.
Targets with more than the allowable number of shots (holes) on it will be penalized by deducting the lowest count of surplus shots from the allowable total. Too few shots are self - penalizing.
Participants will have the opportunity to view their targets from behind a border, before targets are removed.
Scores sheets will be recalculated after each relay and may be viewed on the notice boards.
The Springbok Branch will not buy any prize back or exchange such for cash.
- 3 No computerized scopes. Maximum magnification will be 12 x. Scopes will be sealed at 12 x.
- 4 Any center fire rifle welcome. Any caliber. Any shape. Any barrel. Any attachment. Tri and bi pods may be attached but not used.
- 5 The "Super Skins" will be shot from tables and any other equipment as provided by the Organizers.
- 6 Distance over which shoot is to take place will be announced on day of shoot.
- 7 Scores will be out of total of 60 for each target thus out of 60 total and will be converted to percentage. %
- 8 Equal scores will be subjected to process of elimination.
- 9 There will be no shoot-outs. There will be no "warm up" shots. Thus, know your rifle and its trajectory.
- 10 Orders, instructions and commands as issued by range officers at shooting stations will be binding and shall be adhered to at all times. Range procedures shall be strictly imposed.
- 11 Disputes will be conveyed to the committee and their judgments will be deemed final.
- 12 The same rifle may not be used by different shooters during said relay.
- 13 Where a score line between two scores is broken the higher score will be taken in account.
- 14 Rifles, at all times shall remain in appropriate gun bags and will only be taken out of such, upon instruction of range officer. Muzzles to be pointed down range at all times. Utmost safety shall be adhered too constantly.
- 15 "Supers skins" prizes for completed relays will be handed out directly after each relay.
Main prizes for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc. will be handed out at the end of the day at prize giving ceremony.
Prizes not taken possession of will be handed out at next member meeting or as agreed to with winners.

NOTE:

**ANY SCOPE OF WHICH THE SEAL IS FOUND TO BE TAMPERED WITH AND THE MAX MAGNIFICATION ALTERED TO A LARGER THAN 12X POWER WILL LEAD TO THE DISQUALIFICATION OF PARTICIPANT.
A TWO MINUTE RULE WILL BE APPLIED IN WHICH TIME THE SHOOTER HAS TO READY HIM\HER SELF.**
